

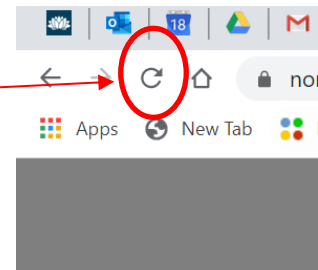
Schools judging day only entries – Instructions

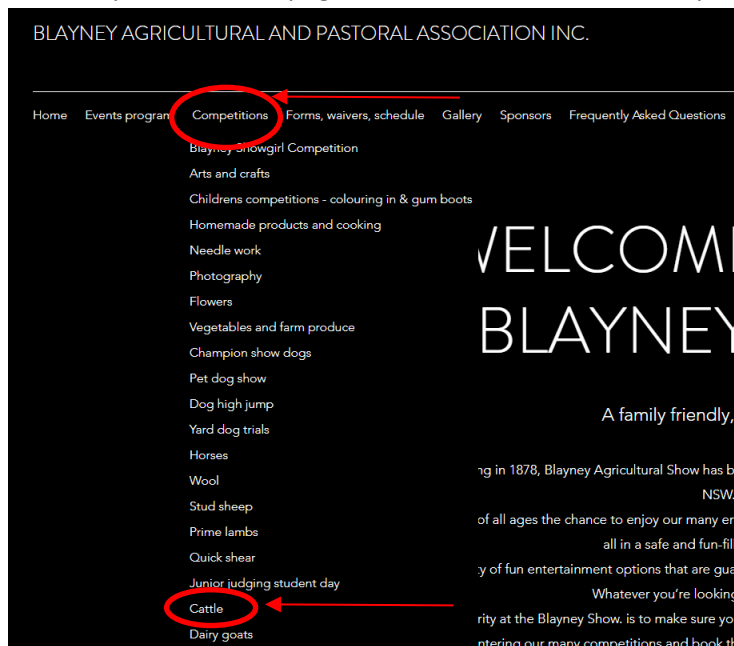

IF YOU HIT BACK YOU WILL LOSE ENTRIES AND HAVE TO START AGAIN

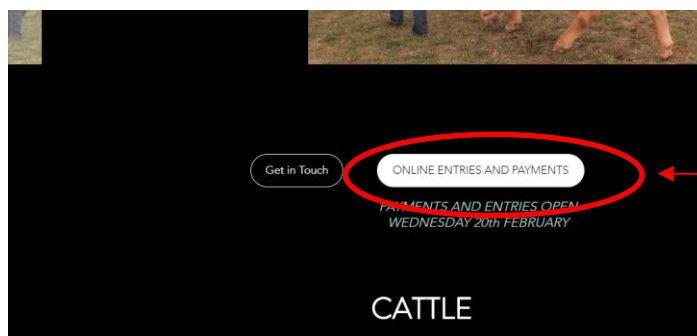


Step 1: Go to www.blayneyshow.com


- At the top of the home page in the site menu select “Competitions > Cattle

Step 3: You will be taken to a landing page. Scroll to the bottom and select “click here to enter”






